

Commercial Pilot Checklist 61.129

- 250 hours total flight time
- 100 hours in powered aircraft 50 minimum in airplanes
- 100 hours PIC to include 50 hours cross country (if instrument rated, 50 hour PIC X/C requirement is already met)
- Other Cross Country flights to reach 50 hours PIC X/C
- Day VFR Cross Country – 2 hours, 100nm
- Night VFR Cross Country – 2 hours, 100nm
- Solo VFR Cross Country – 300nm with landings at three points, one leg must be 250nm straight line distance
- 10 hours dual instrument training
- 10 hours complex/TAA dual training
- 5 hours night VFR solo flight time with 10 takeoffs/landings, in a traffic pattern with an operating control tower
- 3hrs dual in preparation for the practical exam
